- Liaise with coordinators to provide opportunities and pathways program for coaches wishing to upskill and/or obtain FFA qualifications.
- Work with the Corporate Affairs Committee to attract commercial opportunities and raise revenue streams for the club in supporting various programs.
- Work with the Vice President Community Football to establish strategies for strategic Community Football goals and objectives.
- Contribute to the enhancement of internal and external club networks.
- Attend any courses, information nights, meetings designated by GUFC.
- Work with Director Community Football and Director Community Operations to create consistency, sustainability and clear pathways to the Senior and NPL portfolios of the club.
