This would include: Successful marketing, sourcing suitable staff, producing the curriculum and sourcing venue <p>General</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintain a positive working relationship within GUFC Executive, volunteers & all stakeholders • Prepare a monthly report for the GUFC Executive summarizing monthly activities, highlighting areas of concern, success, development programs etc • Liaise with GUFC Referee Coordinator to present opportunities to educate coaches, managers and parents on the rules of the game and code of conduct within GUFC and FA • Conduct player assessments for consideration of exemption as required (i.e. RAE or playing out of age)
